SCHEDULED WATER SHUTDOWN AND TRAFFIC RESTRICTION DECEMBER 27 AND POSSIBLY DECEMBER 28

On Tuesday and possibly extending through Wednesday, December 27 and 28, a DWID subcontractor (Utilities West) will conduct work on the water distribution system in preparation for paving of a part of Deer Trail Road by the County. The paving project is scheduled to commence around January 9.

Traffic will be affected on Deer Trail Road and the intervening side streets from Kendra Lane to Old Mine Road. At various times, traffic access to Deer Trail Road will be restricted at Kendra Lane and Cottontail Road. This restricted traffic is expected to vary at each location between 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M. However, traffic on Deer Trail Road will be completely blocked between Cottontail Road and Old Mine Road.

There will be no through traffic on Deer Trail Road from Kachina Road to Old Mine Road. These traffic restrictions may impact deliveries and garbage collection in these areas.

Water is expected to be shutdown completely during the day along Deer Trail Road from Kendra Lane to Old Mine Road, and including Kendra Lane and Cottontail Road, **between 8:00 A.M. and 4:00 P.M.** It is anticipated water service will not be available to the following lots:

Lots 161 through 164

Lots 166 through 171

Lots 196 through 198

These lot owners should take precautions by shutting off electricity to their water circulation pumps and water heaters, and storing water ahead in potable containers. Make sure faucets are turned off so that water does not flood your home when water service is restored.

This notice is being transmitted to all members in the community who have authorized their email to be used for such purposes, even though the impact of the water shutdown is anticipated to be limited. Whenever underground excavation and pipefitting occurs, there is always the risk that the extent of the impact may extend beyond that anticipated. This notice serves as a community-wide alert. If it appears the number of residences impacted by the work will extend beyond that anticipated, additional alerts will be issued.
